Deepen Your Coaching with Super-Vision

Coach supervision (we prefer “super-vision”) is a reflective practice—a way of exploring and deepening your coaching. Super-vision provides the opportunity to uncover blind spots and patterns that get in your way and hold you back in your coaching.

Considered essential in most of Europe, Super-vision is finding its way to the United States. Nancy Tylim and Ronni Hendel, certified Coaches and Supervisors, are excited to offer this opportunity for you to experience supervision and connect with other coaches with the same commitment to their growth as practitioners.

Peter Hawkins, a pioneer in the field, describes some of the key functions of supervision:

- Supervision helps keep the coach honest and courageous, attending to what they are not seeing, not hearing, not allowing themselves to feel, or not saying
- Supervision helps the coach to develop their internal supervisor and become a better reflective practitioner
- Supervision is a key part of continuous professional development and action learning of the Coach
- Supervision provides a supportive space for the Coach to process what they have absorbed from their clients and their clients' system

How it Works:

- Open to experienced Coaches with at least three active clients
- Groups of 6-8 coaches will gather, via Zoom, for 90-minute sessions monthly, over eight months
- Each session will provide an opportunity for deep reflection through inquiry and reflective conversation
- Nancy and Ronni will guide the conversations using a variety of group methods and tools

Details:

We will be launching two groups in late November—one in the morning and one in the evening Pacific Time. Sessions will be recorded, just in case you miss a session, and shared only with those in your group.

The cost for an eight-session series is \$999.
